

# PETITION TO THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND

## These are the reasons for this petition:

WHEREAS Maritime Electric has an application before the regulator to install two 50MW diesel-fuelled engines on Prince Edward Island;

AND WHEREAS this proposal would lock us into decades of carbon emissions, volatile fuel prices, and higher costs for rate-payers, all while undermining the province's net zero commitments;

AND WHEREAS globally, more than 90% of all new energy production that has been added in the last two years comes from a combination of renewable sources like wind and solar in combination with battery storage;

AND WHEREAS with a government committed to a clean energy future, and with appropriate legislative changes, Prince Edward Island could build a modern and reliable energy system that keeps power affordable and puts Island residents first;

## We petition the Legislative Assembly of Prince Edward Island as follows:

To encourage government to make the necessary legislative changes to allow liberalisation of PEI's electricity grid;

To urge government to do everything possible within its jurisdiction to resist Maritime Electric's diesel-fuelled proposal that is currently before IRAC, and to ensure a modern, affordable, safe, and reliable electricity grid for all Islanders, present and future.
